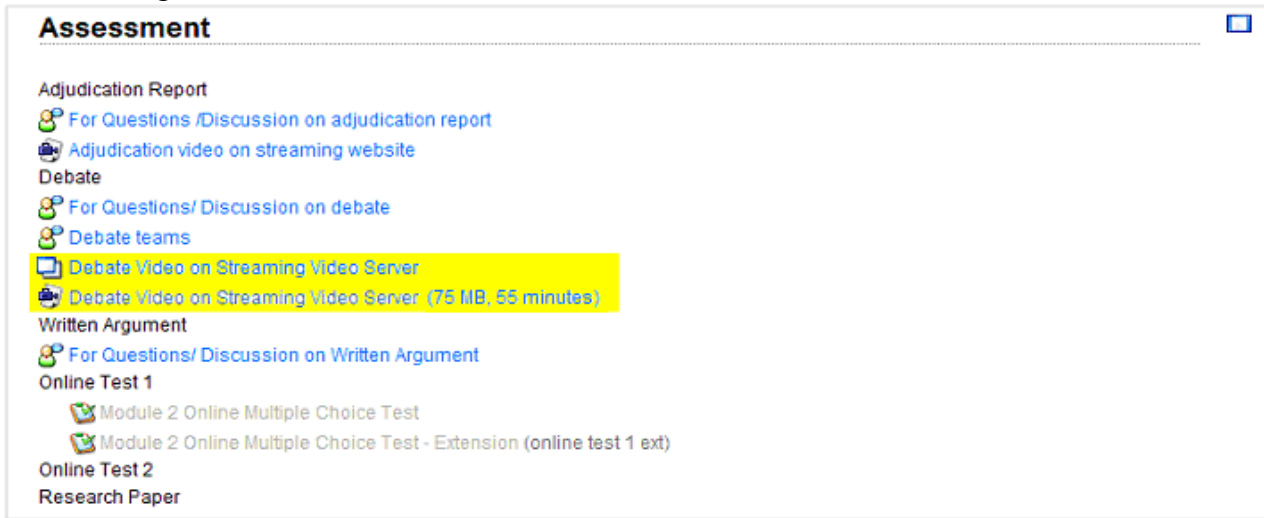


Inserting streaming video in MOODLE

There are two ways of creating a link to a streaming video:

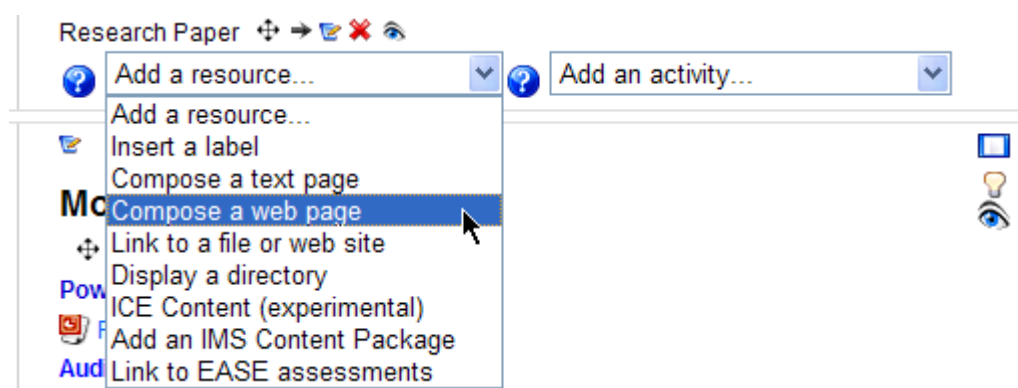
Method 1 – compose a web page	2
Method 2 – link to a file or web site.....	6

This screen grab shows the two results.



Method 1 – compose a web page

The first and better way is to compose a web page and put the link and instructions in that page. Clicking the link will fire off the streaming video using Windows Media Player.

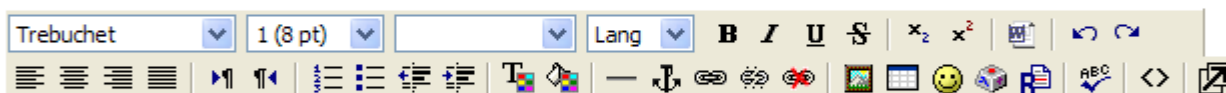

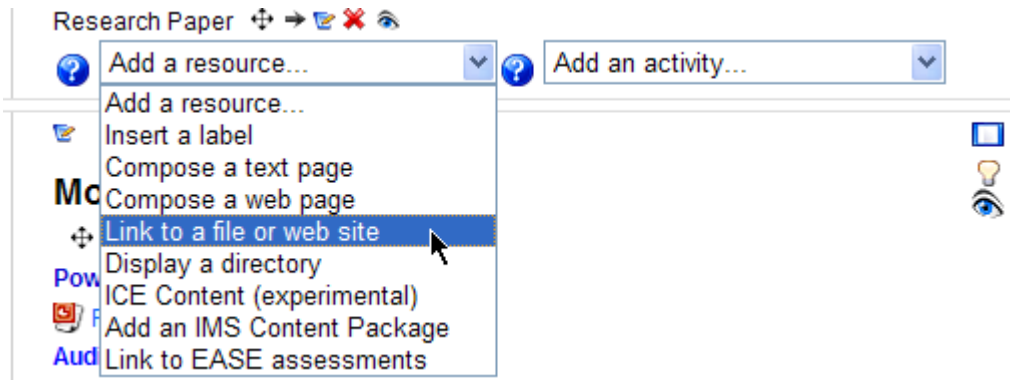

The result is shown below.
