You are advised to begin this process as soon as a position is verbally offered to you so as to acquire a permit in time to commence work.

Successful shortlisted applicants will be required to attend an interview with Ergon Energy. Interviews will be held the week commencing 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2008 in the various regional locations.
