Most of the information you will need to supply is pretty much straight forward. The things you may need to know are the Program name and code, which are

Program Name: Bachelor of Psychology (Honours)
Program Code: BPSH

The four courses you need to enrol in for Semester 1 are

PSY1010 Foundation Psychology A
PSY1101 Critical Thinking
PSY1102 Interpersonal Communication
PSY1104 Psychological Apprenticeship Skills A

You are enrolling ONC (on campus) on the SPRNG (Springfield) campus.

Have a go at getting yourself enrolled for Semester 1. If you strike problems, somewhere in the documentation will be a phone number you can ring. (Finding this number is the second challenge we present you). We will be holding a session during orientation week to ensure that everyone is enrolled as they should be.
