## Program focus

The Bachelor of Commerce and Bachelor of Laws aims to produce graduates who meet the aims and objectives of both the Bachelor of Commerce and the Bachelor of Laws degree programs. This combined degree offers students the benefit of exposure to multiple disciplines.

## Career opportunities

Private practice solicitor or barrister, corporate legal counsel, tax manager, insolvency specialist, forensic investigator, forensic accountant, auditor, chartered accountant, financial institutional lawyer, government sector employee at State or Federal level, non-government agency legal counsel or positions within other business or community organisations requiring specialist in-house legal skills.

## Professional accreditation

The Bachelor of Commerce and Bachelor of Laws has been accredited by the Legal Practitioners Admissions Board, Queensland, and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Queensland as an approved academic qualification under the *Supreme Court (Legal Practitioner Admission) Rules 2004* (Qld). This will partially satisfy the requirements to practise as a solicitor or barrister in Queensland, or as a legal practitioner elsewhere in Australia. Intending solicitors and barristers must also complete an approved practical legal training course

in order to become admitted to practice. USQ law graduates have the option of completing their practical legal training through a one-year traineeship in a law practice, or through a practical legal program offered by USQ's preferred provider or another institution that offers a practical legal training qualification.

Accounting major students will meet the educational entrance requirements of CPA Australia, the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia (ICAA) and the National Institute of Accountants (NIA). (**Note:** Students must also complete [FIN1101 Introduction to Financial Management](#) to meet the requirements of these bodies.) Accounting major students who complete a finance minor will meet the educational entrance requirements of the [Financial Services Institute of Australasia \(Finsia\)](#).

Finance major graduates will meet the educational entrance requirements to become an Associate member of the [Financial Services Institute of Australasia \(Finsia\)](#).

## Program aims

The program aims to produce graduates who meet the aims and objectives of both the Bachelor of Commerce and the Bachelor of Laws degree programs. This combined degree offers students the benefit of exposure to multiple disciplines.

## Admission requirements

## Program fees

### Commonwealth supported place

A Commonwealth supported place is where the Australian Government makes a contribution towards the cost of your higher education and you as a student pay a [student contribution amount](#), which varies depending on the courses undertaken. ### Domestic full fee paying place
