

# Configuring eduroam for USQ Staff

(Mac OS X)



This document contains instructions for setting up your Mac OS X notebook to use **eduroam**. **eduroam** is a wireless infrastructure to allow for inter-institutional roaming. For information on participating institutions in Australia, and the services that are offered, please visit the **eduroam AU** website, and click on the state you wish to visit:

What you need:

1. Wireless-equipped Mac laptop running OS X
2. USQ eduroam certificate

Obtain the certificate from:

Download the certificate and save it to a folder.

## Part 1: Install the Certificate

Browse to where you saved the certificate. Double click on the **usqeduroam.der** certificate.



The **"Add Certificates"** dialogue box will open. Choose the "" Keychain and Click **"OK"**

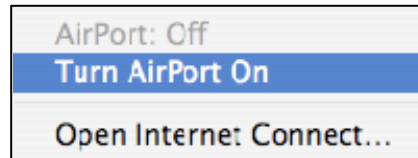


You may be asked to enter your password. If so, do this now (this is the username/password you used to log onto your Mac).

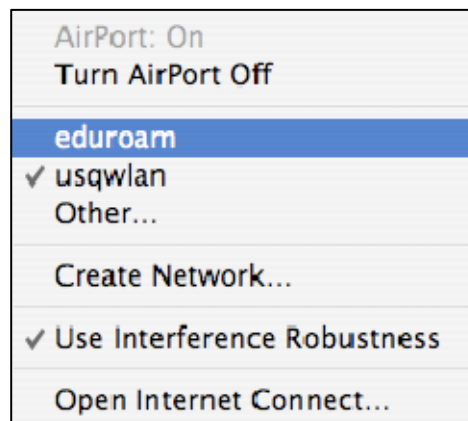


## Part 2: Connecting

Next, **Turn Airport On.**



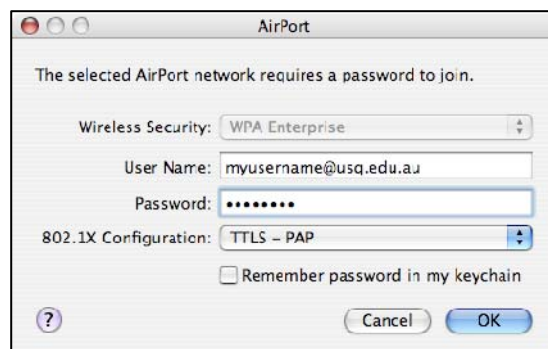
From the list of Wireless Networks in the Airport menu, choose **eduroam**.



This will open the Airport wireless configuration dialogue box. Enter your **username@usq.edu.au** and your **USQconnect** password.

For **802.1X Configuration**, choose **"TTLS – PAP"**.

Click OK.

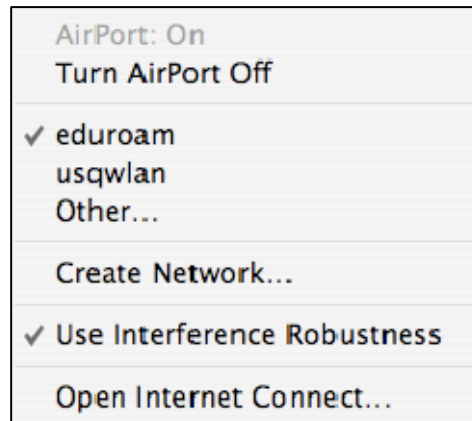


You may see a dialogue box requesting that you **"Verify Certificate"**. Click on **"Continue"**





You should now be connected to **eduroam**.
