Dissemination Framework – Project Level

Engaged

1. Identify potential users and stakeholders
2. Describe strategies to engage with the users – focusing on the intended adoption
3. Identify the range of project outcomes and potential users of the different outcomes etc
4. Describe strategies for enabling each identified group of intended users to become aware of the relevant outcomes and ideas and – involved in making effective use of them.
5. Describe strategies for engaging with intended users and Obtaining feedback during the project
6. Outline evaluation strategies on the impact of project outcomes with the intended user communities during and following the project development.
