TERMINOLOGY	PROGRAM	Study required to complete a degree. For example, to complete the Bachelor of Arts or Business degrees there are 24 courses that need to be completed. These 24 courses make up the degrees program of study.
	COURSE	One subject towards the program. For example, <i>FDN7452 Foundation Accounting</i> is a course of study.
	UNIT	Value of a course of study.
INTERNET PROGRAMS	DISTANCE	Some distance USQ programs are offered through <i>USQOnline</i> via the web. Information and fees for <i>USQOnline</i> programs can be obtained from the following website: http://www.usqonline.com.au or by contacting USQ International.
PROGRAM LOAD PER SEMESTER	ON-CAMPUS	It is normal to study four (4) courses per semester during semesters one and two.
	DISTANCE	It is normal to study two (2) courses per semester.
PROGRAM LOAD PER YEAR	ON-CAMPUS	A normal on-campus study program load per year is equal to eight (8) courses per year during semesters one and two. Students wishing to study additional courses in semester 3 may apply to do so.
	DISTANCE	A normal distance learning program load per year is equal to four (4) courses. Students wishing to study additional courses in semester 3 may apply to do so.
	NOTE	* Some programs offer courses in semester 3. Students may wish to fast track their program by studying extra courses during this semester.
FEES	To establish the approximate cost for an entire program you can multiply the unit fees per course by the total number of units required to complete the program. For example:	
	ON-CAMPUS	Bachelor of Business Degree = Unit cost per course (AUD 1,830) x Number of units (24) = Total program cost (AUD 43,920)
	DISTANCE	Bachelor of Business Degree = Unit cost per course (AUD 1,480) x Number of units (24) = Total program cost (AUD 35,520)
	To establish the cost for a combined degree or cross faculty enrolment for each semester of study you will need to determine the area from which each course is chosen, for example, courses taken from Arts and Science (provided program structure allows).	
	ON-CAMPUS	Bachelor of Arts / Science = 2 Arts Unit cost per course (AUD 1,820) + 2 Science Unit cost per course (AUD 1,980) = Total semester cost (AUD 7,600)
	DISTANCE	Bachelor of Arts / Science = 1 Arts Unit cost per course (AUD 1,540) + 1 Science Unit cost per course (AUD 1,710) = Total semester cost (AUD 6,500)
