4.6.5 POLICY ON DOMESTIC STUDENTS IN FEE-PAYING UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS**POLICY**

1. Admission of Australian citizens to undergraduate fee-paying places in any particular program requires the approval of the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendation of the Dean, except where the student has run out of Student Learning Entitlement, or the student chooses not to be Commonwealth Supported in a program and has notified USQ in writing.
2. From 1 January 2005, Australian permanent residents and New Zealand citizens may be admitted as fee-paying students in undergraduate programs, subject to meeting the entry requirements of that program and to the availability of a place.
3. All domestic students, including fee-paying undergraduate and post-graduate students, will be admitted and enrolled through Student Administration and not through agents.
