## CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

Clinical Psychology involves the diagnosis and treatment of mental disorders. It emphasises understanding, preventing, & relieving psychologically based distress and dysfunction and promotes subjective well-being and personal development.

### Clinical Psychologists assist people of all ages by using:

- thorough clinical assessment tools, including personality tests, symptom checklists, neuropsychometric tests
- planned interventions to meet individual client needs
- evidence-based treatment approaches
- systematic outcome measures
- reports to referrer.

## HEALTH PSYCHOLOGY

Health Psychology involves the promotion and maintenance of physical and mental health. It emphasises the psychological factors in the cause, progression and consequences of health and illness.

### Health Psychologists assist people in:

- developing and maintaining the behaviours necessary to lead a healthy life
- preventing illness, particularly where people are at risk of disease or illness
- understanding, coping and adjusting to living with illness
- complying with medical procedures and medication
- helping relatives and friends cope with the illness of others.



## GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY PRACTICE

General psychological services are offered including the counselling/psychotherapy and support of people who are experiencing stress, lifestyle changes and adjustment issues, relationship problems and other behavioural and emotional difficulties affecting their overall well-being.

### Assessment Services related to:

- neuropsychological disorders
- stress and coping
- learning difficulties
- adjustment to acute or chronic illness
- personality issues.
