LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

There are no mandatory English Language level requirements for participation. We will provide an interpreter (at an additional cost) for groups with very little previous English experience.

ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION

A wide range of accommodation is available in Toowoomba.

Accommodation will be selected to meet the needs and budget of the group.

Homestay accommodation gives participants an opportunity to experience the lifestyle of an Australian family and to make lifelong friends. On overnight sightseeing trips, a high standard of accommodation is assured. All transfers to USQ campus daily for lectures and other activities are included. Also, organised tours, which form part of the official program, are inclusive of all transport costs.

CATERING

All programs include breakfast, lunch and evening meals.

TRAVEL AND MEDICAL INSURANCE

Fee-paying overseas program participants are not covered by Australia's national health scheme. It is a mandatory requirement of acceptance into a program, that all participants obtain comprehensive Medical and Travel Insurance before departing for Australia.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

The CLLT is not responsible for issuing visas, for visa information, acceptance or attainment. Program participants should contact the nearest Australian Embassy, High Commission or Consulate for information about the conditions of relevant visas and to obtain their visa before leaving their home country.

COST

The CLLT is happy to provide costings on any combination of modules at any time. No costings have been provided in this brochure, as individual module costs vary dependent upon time of year and number of participants. Our total program price, when calculated, includes return coach transfers from Brisbane, accommodation, tours, activities and catering, education kits including all necessary learning materials and Certificates of Completion issued by USQ. We also provide academic and management support staff, and a 24-hour emergency contact.

PAYMENT

Upon finalisation of the program, a contract is prepared which specifies the deposit and final payment figures and due dates. A deposit equating 20 % of the total cost is generally required at least two months prior to arrival in Australia, with the final balance due at least one month prior to arrival.
