ICT Services and the Faculty of Business & Law have acquired a site licence for MSDNAA Software. ICT Services manages the software and software distribution. *The University does not offer support for use of the software*.

Installation Guidelines:	 You must be a student enrolled in the Faculty of Business & Law Course CIS2003. For certain products, you may require a product key for installing the software. You may NOT disclose the product key to anyone else.
Usage Guidelines	 You may not give copies of loaned or downloaded software to anyone else. Other eligible students must obtain software using the method(s) set up by the Division of ICT Services. You may use the software for non-commercial purposes including instructional was research and/or design, and development and testing of
	 instructional use, research and/or design, and development and testing of projects for class assignments, tests, or personal projects. You may not use MSDNAA software for any for-profit software development. When you are no longer enrolled in the Course CIS2003, you may no longer obtain MSDNAA Software.
	• If you violate the terms of the EULA and the License Amendment, ICT Services will demand confirmation of removal of the program software from your personal computer.

You will need to obtain a Product Key before installing the software. To do this you are required to complete the Application Form and return using one of the following methods:
