LOCATION AND PARKING

Classes will be held in T Block (circled area on map) off Baker Street.

From the pedestrian crossing, follow the path under the building – T122 will be the second room on the left hand side – the room is numbered and there will be signs for the Mathematics Enrichment Program displayed.
