Integrated Articulation and Credit Transfer Project

The Project Team

The Integrated Articulation and Credit Transfer Project is being conducted by the University of Southern Queensland (USQ) in collaboration with the Department of Education and Training (DET), Australian Council for Private Providers and Training (ACPET) and the Careers Australia Group (CAG).

The project is funded by the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR) through their Diversity and Structural Adjustment Fund. The project is being conducted from May 2009 – May 2011.

Project Overview

The Integrated Articulation and Credit Transfer Project responds to identified Federal Government priorities and initiatives, which place a strong emphasis on the provision of more streamlined pathways between the VET and Higher Education sectors with an expected increased collaboration between the two sectors, both at a strategic and delivery level.

The overall aim of the project is to improve and develop further cross-sectoral articulation models, which are responsive to specific industry needs and support the development of innovative pathways between the two tertiary sectors. The outcomes will be transferable across education and training organisations, both private and public, to ultimately provide significant benefit to students. To achieve these outcomes input is required from all key stakeholders in the education and training sectors and the relevant industry organisations.

Project Focus

The project will focus on the following key areas:

- current and emerging articulation and credit transfer models in Australia and overseas
- effective best practice models of articulation and credit transfer for specific industry areas
- patterns of student movement between the two sectors
- awareness by students of articulation and credit transfer opportunities
- inter-sectoral infrastructure and system requirements to enable articulation and credit transfer arrangements
- key policy initiatives and research in the area of articulation and credit transfer arrangements.
