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Road Blocks

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- “Scholarship” vs Research
 - Must publish to make ‘investment’ worth while
 - Peer reviewed; DEST reportable = RESEARCH
 - Learning and Teaching is *real* research
 - Based in literature and theory; rigorous; validated
- Novice to Expert
 - Incentive and encouragement to start –
 - Secondary research area needs more support (\$\$\$\$)
 - Generally rewards are provided at end but assistance needs to be at beginning of journey
- EERG success dependent on management support
 - Little access or input to a Centre
 - L&T practice and research would benefit from cross disciplinary input
- Lacking a pool of research assistants/assistance
- Not a lot of avenues for external money – need help in finding sources


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
