### Faculty Awards (Individual - \$1,000, Team - \$2,000)

On the recommendation of the Faculty Excellence in Teaching Award Selection Panel through the Associate Dean (Learning & Teaching), the Dean may award annually the following:

- Faculty Awards for Teaching Excellence
- Faculty Awards for Teaching Excellence (Early Career)
- Faculty Awards for Programs or Services
- Commendations for Achievement in Learning and Teaching

### USQ Awards (Individual - \$ 5,000, Team - \$10,000)

On the recommendation of the Pro Vice-Chancellor (Learning & Teaching), the Vice-Chancellor may award annually the following

- Up to three (3) Awards for Teaching Excellence
- Up to three (3) Awards for Programs and Services that Enhance Learning
- Up to five (5) University Citations for Outstanding Contributions to Student Learning
