Alumnus of the Year Awards

Award guidelines

- The nominee has received an Award (as defined in the USQ Policy and Procedure Library) from the University of Southern Queensland or one of its predecessor institutions: Queensland Institute of Technology Darling Downs, Darling Downs Institute of Advanced Education or University College of Southern Queensland.
- 2. Nominations for awards may be submitted by other USQ Alumni, USQ or partner institute staff, employers or work colleagues, members of the community, family members or friends.
- 3. No self-nominations will be accepted.
- 4. Current USQ staff and USQ Council members are ineligible for nomination.
- 5. Nominees must have been graduates for 3 or more years. For example, nominees for 2018 must have graduated no later than 31 December 2014.
- 6. Nominees need not be employed in their trained discipline.
- 7. Nominees for the Indigenous Alumnus of the Year Award must be open to an alumnus of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent.
- 8. Nominees for the International Alumnus of the Year award must have been living and working in a country other than Australia for more than three consecutive years.
- 9. The Young Alumnus of the Year is to be awarded to an individual under 35 years of age as of the 31 December in the year of award.
- 10.Finalists are strongly encouraged to attend and receive the award in person.
