Definitions

Nominee: The person being nominated for an Alumnus of the Year Award.

Nominator: The person who nominates another person for an Alumnus of the Year Award.

Alumnus: An individual who has completed a course of study at the University of Southern Queensland, or its predecessor institutions - Queensland Institute of Technology- Darling Downs (QIT-DD), Darling Downs Institute of Advanced Education (DDIAE), or University College of Southern Queensland (UCSQ), as a domestic, international undergraduate and/or postgraduate student.

Year of graduation: Is the year in which the graduation ceremony was held of an alumnus nominated to the award. This is noted on their testamur, the certificate they received upon their graduation.

Awards Categories

Nominees for awards are judged upon their demonstrated success in professional, research, academic, entrepreneurship, leadership, management, community service, volunteer and/or humanitarian endeavours.

Outstanding Alumnus in Business and Enterprise

This award is presented to an alumnus who, at the time of submission of their nomination, has distinguished themselves through professional, academic and/or community service.

Outstanding Alumnus in Creative Industries and Humanities

This award is presented to an alumnus who, at the time of submission of their nomination, has distinguished themselves through professional, academic and/or community service.

Outstanding Alumnus in Education

This award is presented to an alumnus who, at the time of submission of their nomination, has distinguished themselves through professional, academic and/or community service.

Outstanding Alumnus in Health and wellbeing

This award is presented to an alumnus who, at the time of submission of their nomination, has distinguished themselves through professional, academic and/or community service.

Outstanding Alumnus in Law and Justice

This award is presented to an alumnus who, at the time of submission of their nomination, has distinguished themselves through professional, academic and/or community service.

Outstanding Alumnus in Science and Engineering

This award is presented to an alumnus who, at the time of submission of their nomination, has distinguished themselves through professional, academic and/or community service.

Young Alumnus of the Year

This award is presented to an alumnus whose age at the nomination is 35 years or less, who has distinguished themselves through early professional, academic and/or community service achievement and success.

At least one written reference and referee details

Written permission from the nominee for the nomination
