VIRTUAL PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Students will participate in culture and awareness sessions and meet with staff and teachers at the selected Cambodian School located in Siem Reap, working with teachers to develop course books for specific age groups.

As pre-service teachers, they will also have the opportunity to deliver a prepared session in English to school children and present it in a booklet to the school at the end of the program.

The overall aim of this project is for the USQ pre-service teachers to make a real and sustainable contribution to the school and local community.
