## DAVIS DINNER DANCE

The autumn dinner dance of Davis College will be held on Friday, 3 June, 1988. Pre-dinner drinks will be available from 6.30p.m. for a smorgasbord dinner at 7.00p.m. Following the dinner, dancing will commence and will continue till 1.00a.m.

Residents of college are invited at no extra cost. Outside guests, however, may be invited at a charge of \$14.00 per person.

## INTER-SEMESTER BREAK

The inter-semester break of three weeks starts from Saturday, 25 June 1988. If you haven't made arrangements to stay in College during the break you would be required to vacate your room by Saturday, 25 June before 10.00a.m.

Warden's Office will be open on that day from 8.00a.m. to 10.00a.m. for booking-out purposes.

## BOOKING-OUT PROCEDURE

1. Clear your room of all your belongings. You can use the store room for storage.
2. Remove all posters and wall hangings.
3. Leave your room tidy and place rubbish in the bins outside your block.
4. Remove bed linen and place it to one side of your room.
5. Turn off light and heater switch and close windows.
6. Bring your room key to Warden's Office and sign out.

Residents intending to bring extra heaters for their rooms after the inter-semester recess, please note the charges, etc. listed on page 14 of the Residential College Handbook.

Information about extra heaters or fridges must be provided to office on your arrival.

## RETURN TO COLLEGE AFTER VACATION

Please note carefully that booking-in following vacations will be only between the hours of 1.00p.m. to 5.00p.m. on Sunday, 17 July 1988.

Due to use of college places, earlier booking-in will not be convenient. Please make sure you make travel arrangements accordingly.

During your inter-semester break you may store your packed suitcases, etc. in your block store room. Please check with your Resident Fellow as to which box rooms are to be used for storage purposes.
