## MID-SEMESTER BREAK

Residents who have not made arrangements to remain in College during the mid-semester break (9.9.89 - 17.9.89) are required to vacate their rooms by 10a.m. on Saturday, 9 September.

Those wishing to depart college prior to 5p.m. on Friday, 8 September may do so by signing out and handing their room key in at the Warden's Office.

## BOOKING-OUT

Booking out will be undertaken in individual colleges on Saturday, 9 September between 8a.m. and 10a.m. Senior Resident Fellows will announce details of arrangements. Please observe the following booking-out procedures:

- Clear your room of all belongings. Gear can be stored in block box rooms. (Box room key available from the Warden's Office.)
- Remove all posters and wall hangings.
- Leave your room tidy and place rubbish in the bins provided outside your block.
- Remove the bed linen and place it to one side of your room.
- Turn off lights and heater. Lock windows and doors when you leave.
- Return your key to the appropriate Resident Fellow and sign out.

## BOOKING-IN

Booking-in after the vacation will be in individual colleges on Sunday, 17 September between 1p.m. and 5p.m. You are requested to make your travel arrangements accordingly.

No booking-in facilities will be available outside these hours unless prior arrangements have been made by contacting the Deputy Warden (076 31 2651) during office hours or your Resident Fellow.
