# HEATER TIMES DURING WINTER MONTHS

In all Colleges, the room heaters are controlled by a timing device. Generally, the heaters are scheduled to operate between 5pm and 2am during the night and between 6am and 9am each morning. However, during very cold weather the Warden's Office will arrange to have the heaters operational for the entire day. Please note that such adjustments should only be effected through the Warden's Office.

Steele Rudd and Concannon Colleges have staggered "switch on" times in order to avoid a power failure due to a surge of power that may result if all heaters come on at the same time. The schedule for these Colleges is as follows:
