The students gain experience in studying and living in Germany and have the chance to give their studies an European dimension. Courses held at Hessen state universities are free of charge for Hessen and international students except of fees for welfare services and regional public transportation (Semesterticket). The program does not cover travel, visa, medical and living expenses in Germany.</i></p>
