The struggle to establish a university:

- Minute of the Public Meeting held on 2nd December 1960 that led to the establishment of the Darling Downs University Establishment Association (DDUEA)
- Photo of the 'Barnstorming Tour' in 1963. A fundraising tour made in a small Piper Comanche aircraft visiting fourteen towns from Stanthorpe to Charleville in three days.

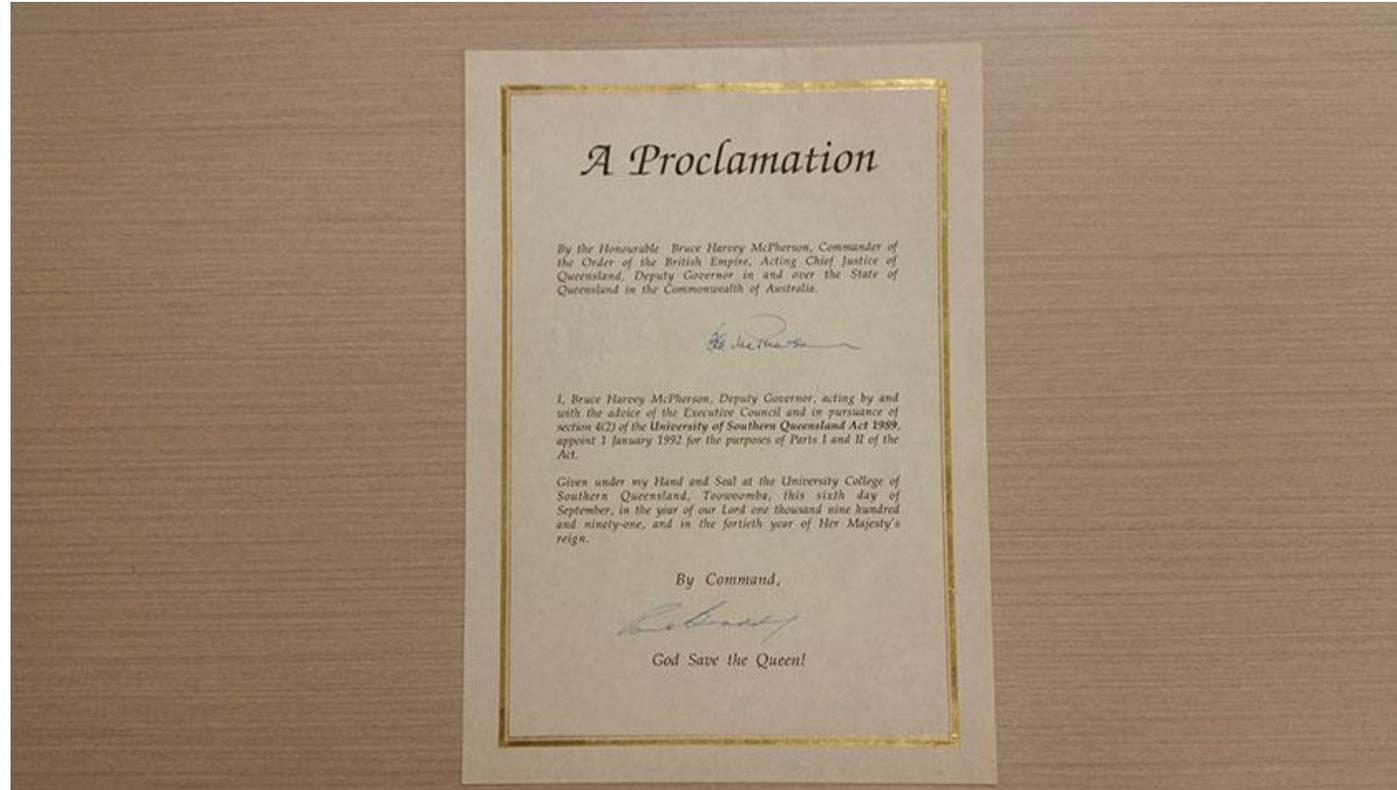
